Important Dates & Information:

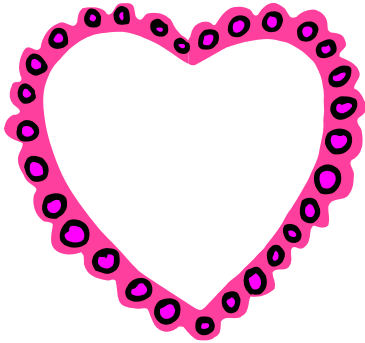
