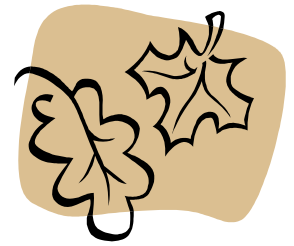


October Newsletter 2018

Dear Families,

The children have done a wonderful job of settling into the routine of school. We have many fun activities for the month of October.

Question of the Month: Each month the Pre-K will be asked to learn an answer to an important question, in an effort to better prepare them for kindergarten. The question for October is “What is your first and last name?” The teachers will be testing the children at the end of the month.

Dear Parents,
Halloween is just around the corner and we would like to celebrate the holiday in a special way with our children.

DATE: **Wednesday, October 31st**

WHAT TO WEAR: Children are encouraged to come to school dressed in a friendly Halloween costume.
(No guns, swords, or knives permitted)

PARENTS: The children will perform a few “Halloween Songs” for parents & guests. The time is as follows:
11:00 a.m. for the morning class
2:00 p.m. for the afternoon class.

We ask you to wait in the hallway until the teachers ask you to come in. Please be prompt, as not to miss. Please enter quietly, as it may be overwhelming for some children and it can be difficult to hear their tiny voices when singing. The class will be seated in a group & cameras are welcome.

TRICK OR TREAT: After we sing parents/guests are asked to line up in the hall (please start the line by the steps and stay on one side of the hall) to pass out your treats. We ask families to supply treats for each child and a few extra for those siblings who wish to participate. 20 Treats is a safe number.

DISMISSAL: Teachers will dismiss your child to you immediately following “Trick or Treat”.
